The text box on the left-hand side contains information about the selected indicator.

This may be supplemented with information about data sources and geographic levels. On some pages, it will give high-level information about the topic.

Filters allow users to find the information that they are interested in. Some pages will contain multiple filters. They are ordered from left to right, with the leftmost filters affecting the content of those on the right. Therefore, filters should always be selected in this order.

On this page, we can make a selection on the choose a geography filter too, for example.

The legend explains the meaning of the colours used in the graphs.

Each page contains different types of data visualisations. Some are tables, others will show the most recently available data for the filters selected. Elsewhere in the JSNA you will find data that is presented on maps too.

By right-clicking anywhere on a graph, you will be able to view it as a table by selecting Show as Table.

You can return to the report by clicking the Back to Report button.

Hovering over any of the data points on a graph will provide further detail. These are called tooltips.

Hover over a graph and click the icon in the top right corner to enlarge it. This is called focus mode.

Scroll bars let users access information that cannot be displayed in the initial window.

This box provides information about the quality of the data for the selected indicator. Some data may come with warnings or caveats.

Finally, the bars at the bottom of the dashboard present a number of options. The arrows can be used to navigate between the pages in sequential order.

The zoom buttons can be used to zoom in or out of the page.
